If you work as a manager in a licenced premises, it is a legal requirement to hold a Licence Controller Qualification under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act (2012). This course is compromised of the two unit standards that make up the theory component of the LCQ – the prerequisite when applying for a Manager's Certificate.



Entry Requirements

- Previous experience working with the sale of alcohol in a licenced premises
- No age restriction to complete the course, but applicants need to be over the age of 20 to gain a Managers Certificate
- Access to the internet and a computer is required for assessment purposes



Course Content

- You have the option of attending a 1 day course with some pre-learning or study via distance learning
- Units covered:
 - US 4646 Demonstrate knowledge of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and its implications for licenced premises
 - US 16705 Demonstrate knowledge of host responsibility requirements as a duty manager of licensed premises
- Once achieved, apply through your District Licencing Authority for registration
